

Still, more importantly, the mini tome served as a manifesto of sorts that would define his life's work.

When he was 19, he had his first photographs and article published in a magazine. When he was 20, he earned his first magazine cover. By his own admission, the work now appears marginal and sophomoric. It was the spark, however, that ignited the fire to keep him going and perfect his creative craft.


Feel free to add a small watermark to your images so everyone knows who took what. If you used Lightroom you can do this in the Export stage. Most other programs offer a watermark option.

KWPC Birding Adventure Trip to Bosque del Apache Wildlife Refuge in New Mexico


December 1, 2024, to December 7, 2024
